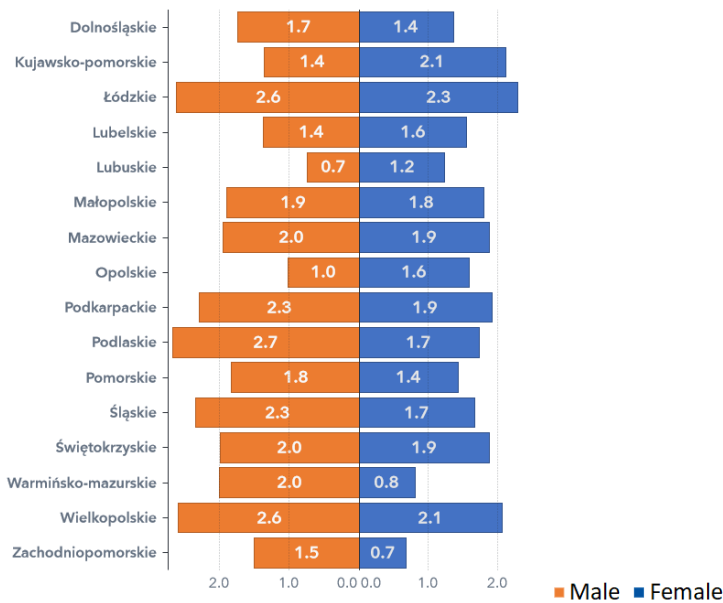
Incidence by sex



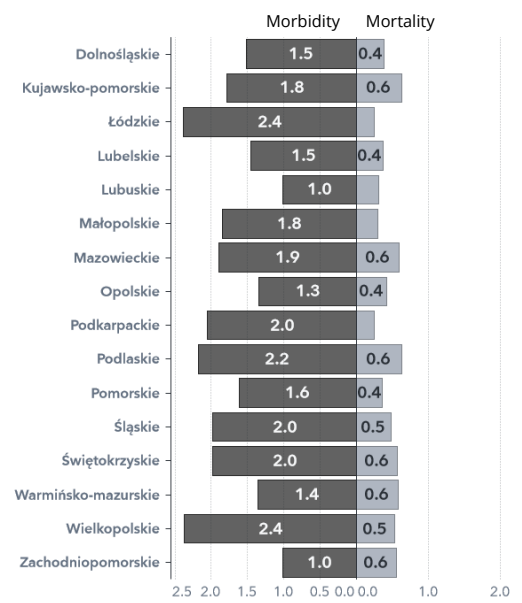
Incidence by sex
