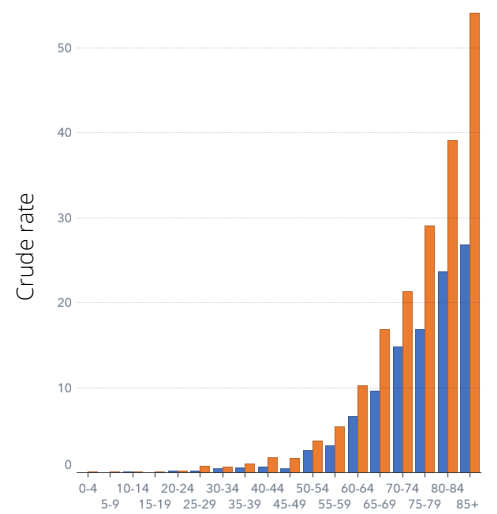
### Deaths, females



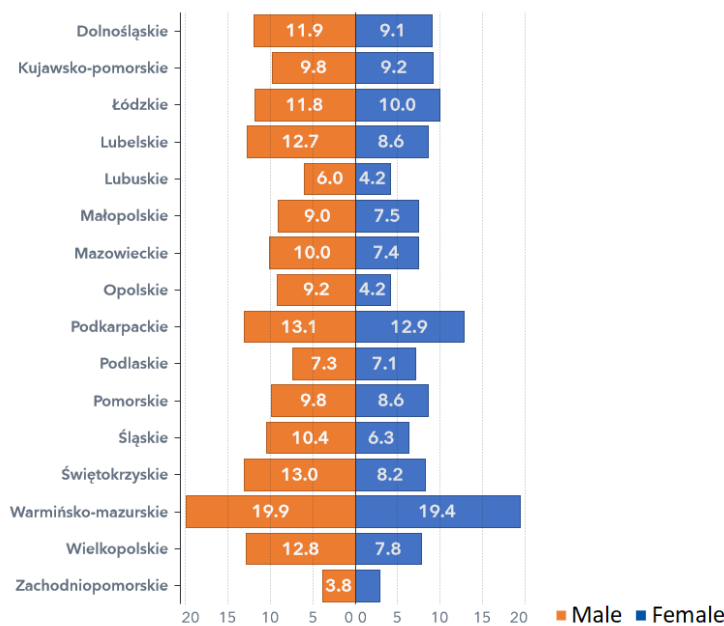
### Incidence by sex



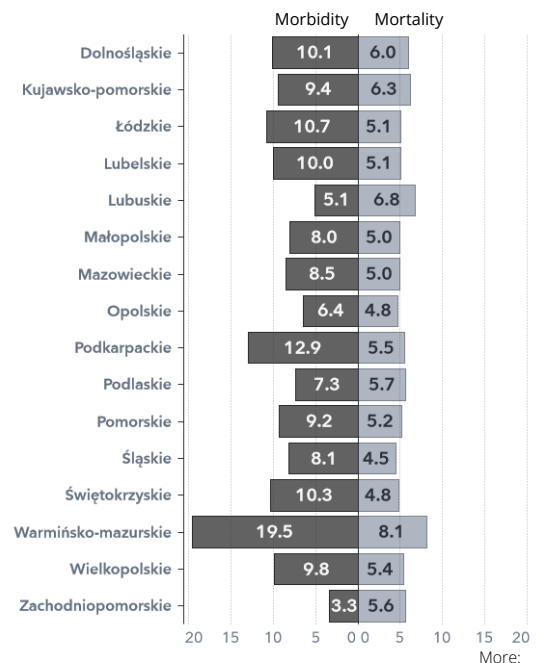
